Topic: Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons in the Russo-Ukrainian War

Honorable Chairs,

Nuclear weapons are the wicked part of the human. The potential of nuclear weapons have been seen such as Nagasaki and Hiroshima in World War 2. The Kyrgyz Republic wants to demonstrate the importance of continued peace and hope for the future.

We are supporting NPT and CTBT to not use nuclear weapons. We have signed a protocol agreement with the IAEA. The agreements, which we have mentioned before, must strengthen and develop or constitute another agreement for irreversible limits. Also for the Russo-Ukrainian, we should call for an end to war. This conflict has not ended and it will continue when a country is occupied. The key element of a better future comes within peace. We stand ready for peaceful solutions with both of the countries.
