The Federal Republic of Germany became a member of NATO on 6 May 1955. As the delegate of Germany which is a fully sovereign country, Our main strategy towards the East is coordinated with our precious allies in North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). This structure is based on a mutual recognition between the NATO and Warsaw Pact.

There is no doubt that we strengthen NATO's existence for the eastern part of the Alliance. In the name of Cold War, we were the front line of the Cold War in Europe for 40 years. We contributed one of the largest militaries in the Alliance. Moreover, We have sent 12,000 troops to Steadfast Defender which was literally the largest NATO venture since the Cold War. We would like to emphasize that we are the biggest European contributor for the needed military aid.

Our very first National Security Strategy was published on June 14, 2023. It was focusing on our role on the matter.

Recently, We had to reconsider our security adaptation because of Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Some shifts have occurred in the name of our foreign policy. Our National Security Strategy claims that the main threat for the security and peace in the Euro-Atlantic area in the future is Russia. We have sent the Patriot system to Ukraine and we strongly encourage other Allies to cooperate with us on this point.
