Thank you, honorable chairman and fellow all delegates;

As a member of the Security Council, we take this issue seriously and are ready to do our best to resolve it. We recognize both sides of this war politically and we think that it is their most natural right to defend themselves, but this massacre in Palestine did not affect a single region but caused deep pain all over the world. Dead, wounded, sick, and even starving children are not a matter of politics and state interests, alliances and international support or self-defense. It is simply a crime and a denial of any humanity As Slovenia, we cannot turn a blind eye to such cruelty, and we believe that Israel's defense of itself is completely justified. Slovenia rejects and condemns the recent statements by the Israeli authorities proposing a massive relocation of Palestinians from Gaza. At the same time, we are concerned about the conditions in which the people of Gaza live, from malnutrition, the lack of drinking water and other basic needs to the spread of disease and unsafe shelters. Houses and neighbourhoods have turned to rubble, and people are forced to flee time and again As Slovenia, we are completely in favor of the two-state solution option. But we are ready to work with the valuable delegates here for a solution-oriented, peaceful world to ensure that a ceasefire is signed immediately in the region and this conflict ends.. Slovenia supports that military solution is never an answer nor the war is.
