The United Arab Emirates borders Oman and Saudi Arabia in the southeast of the Arabian Peninsula in the Middle east.

The United Arab Emirates was established in 1971 by the coming together of the 6 emirates consisting of Abu Dhabi, Sharjah, Fujairah, Umm Al Quwain and Ajman Emirates and Blahare Al Khaimah joined the federation on 10 February 1972. Petroleum products and natural gases, as well as aluminum pearl dates and dried fish. As a food and agriculture organization, we will help develop water resources, as pecially irrigation, in the United Arab Emirates.

Water resources; It can be improved through studies such as purifying sea water, purifying waste, water and transferring water, getting water companies to stop leaks, installing water meters and increasing water prices, investing in reservoirs.

The United Arab Emirates (UAE), one of the countries that consume the most water in the world, established the world's largest drinking water tank under the Liva Desert.

The UAE opened the doors of the world's largest water tank for the first time yesterday, as part of the 2018 International Water Summit held in Abu Dhabi.

The tank built by the UAE, which has established many water purification facilities in the country thanks to its oil revenues despite its limited water resources, will be the world's largest water reserve made by artificial means. Authorities stated that such a facility is needed due to the increasing water demand in the country and the risks posed by climate change.

There are 26 billion liters of water in the giant water tank under the Liwa Desert in the south of the country. It was reported that it took 26 months to fill the tank and that the tank would provide nearly 100 million liters of water per day in case of an emergency.

The water tank, whose construction started in 2002, cost 450 million dollars. The water accumulated in the tank is transported through large pipes.

The amount of water consumed daily in the UAE, which has a population of nearly 10 million, reaches 6 billion liters. Water consumption in the country is well above that of many Western countries, depending on weather conditions and income. We want to invite you to join us to work together.
