Agenda Item: REFUGEE problem in Europe.

Country: France

The new immigration law has been adopted in France. According to the law, which will become final after it is published in the official gazette, rental support and family allowances for foreigners living in the country are conditioned on working. Working foreigners will be able to benefit from rental support 3 months after arriving in France, and non-working foreigners will be able to benefit from rent support after 5 years. Likewise, foreigners who have a home will be able to access family benefits 30 months after arriving in the country, and those who do not have a job will be able to access family benefits after 5 years. According to the law, dual citizens who commit crimes against security forces may be stripped of their French citizenship.

There are many reasons why refugees leave their home countries and migrate to other countries. However, a few of these problems stand out. The most important of these is that human rights do not work in some countries. Another problem is wars. Many countries disappear as wars occur. Economic difficulties are another problem of ours. People migrate to various countries to fix their financial problems.

There are also solutions to these problems. We want to start with wars. For this, peace must be established between countries and peace agreements must be signed for ongoing wars. We continue with economic difficulties. For economic difficulties, people should be given better job opportunities and the economy should be improved in order to improve their financial situation.
